PLACEMENT INKINDERGARTENS

When a child is offered a place in the nursery, the offer will last till the start of school in august.

STARTUP

You will receive a separate letter with the date and branch of the kindergarten child to begin on.

When your child starts kindergarten, it is important that one of the parent follows the child the first few days. Some employers give parents time off with Lonnie connection with this. This you must find out for yourself by asking your employer

You agree with the teacher how much time your child needs you in kindergarten.

Let the children bring a teddy bear, pacifier or other things they enjoy snuggle with.

Kindergarten would like to know what you parents think is important for the child.



DELIVERY AND PICK UP IN DAY-CARE

Notify the staff when you arrive with your child and when you pick up. Take time to talk to staff and ask if you have any questions.

It is important that you give notice when other than the parents to pick up the child in kindergarten.

ABSENCE from kindergarten Kindergarten should be notified when the child does not come because of illness, holiday or vacation.

Vacation: All children should have vacation during the summer.

Sick children should normally be at home. If your child becomes ill at day care the parents will be contacted.



CLOTHES AND EQUIPMENT Children and adults are out for a while every day and need clothes that fit all kinds of weather.



Each child gets their own shelf in the locker room where they can have their own clothes. Parents are responsible to keep the shelves in order.

Parents must provide for appropriate changes of clothing according to seasons. It is important to have the changes of clothing on the shelf such as underwear, pants, socks, jumpers and diapers for those who need it.

It is also important that the child is provided with thin lace dress, rain gear, boots. During all seasons. And in winter time the child will need gloves, hat, scarf, mittens, thermal underwear, fleece – clothes, warm winter boots (Gore-Tex is good) and a thick suit.



SHOES FOR USE INSIDE THE KINDERGARTEN

The children use slippers or sandals in the nursery.

MEALS

The food in the nursery should be healthy and nutritious and contain little sugar. It is recommended to avoid juices and sweet pastries in their children's packed lunches on regular days.



BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION

It is a tradition that the staff of the kindergarten marks the child's birthday. How this is done varies from nursery to nursery.

INTERPRETER IN KINDERGARTENS

Kindergartens can book an interpreter through the interpreting service Sometimes it's important to have an interpreter at the start so that the staff and parents should be confident that they have understood each other.

PLANS FOR WORK IN THE KINDERGARTEN

All kindergartens have their own annual plans that will be handed out to the parents.

The plans tell how the children will gain confidence, care, experience and learning. All nurseries have staff well qualified employees to ensure that children get a good daycare
